## Program overview and objectives

The 2017 Adult Critical Care Conference will feature lectures, case presentations and educational sessions on a variety of acute and critical care issues facing health care professionals today. This one day conference will focus on current trends in the management of acute and critical care patients. 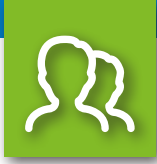
