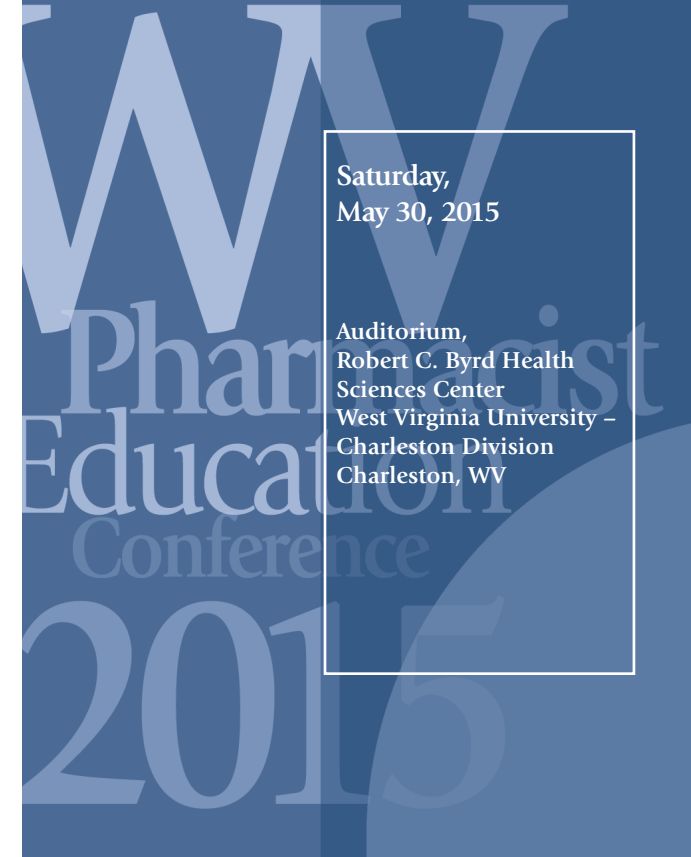
Full refunds are guaranteed until the day before the conference. If you cannot attend, you may elect to send a substitute from your organization.
